PETER ASHER

This Grammy-winning record producer (James Taylor, Linda Ronstadt), performing artist, guitarist and singer has ten Top 40 hits including "World Without Love" (written by Paul McCartney) with Peter & Gordon. In 1968, Peter became Director of A&R at Apple Records where he found, signed and produced James Taylor and worked closely with the Beatles on their individual projects. They earned a spot in the hearts of Classic Rock lovers for their smooth style and tight harmonies. Brian Epstein chose The Cyrkle to open for The Beatles on their 1966 Summer tour before crowds of 70,000. The exposure sent their debut single, "Red Rubber Ball" to number 2 on the Billboard Hot 100 in 1966. Ellie Morgan

An acoustic pop sensation native to the Charlotte area, Ellie performs in local venues four to five nights a week, covering popular tunes from the likes of the Eagles to Adele, as well as her own original songs influenced by Taylor Swift and Colbie Caillat. The Sammies

This Charlotte-based Southern/Indie Rock band includes Will Huntley (guitar/vocals), Joe Huntley (drums/vocals), CR Rollyson (bass guitar), Ben Levine (guitar/vocals), and Adam Little (guitar/vocals). They have performed from coast to coast and at SXSW and Sundance Film Festival. Their songs are used in film (*Employee of the Month*) and on television (*Friday Night Lights*, *Entourage*). Kate Lee & Forrest O'Connor

This Folk duo earned recognition as lead singers and songwriters of the Mark O'Connor Band, whose first album, *Coming Home*, debuted at #1 on Billboard's Bluegrass Albums Chart and won a GRAMMY Award (2017). Kate (vocals, violin) and Forrest (vocals, guitar, mandolin) have performed at the Grand Ole Opry, Ryman Auditorium, and Fenway Park, and at some of the most prominent festivals and concert halls around the country. kateandforrest.com

Homegrown in the QC, Shana has been a long-time fixture in Charlotte's music community, including singing with the TMP Singalong Choir for more than 2 decades. Throughout her life, she's been influenced by a wide variety of genres, and she applies that diversity to unique adaptations of cover songs, as well as to her own songwriting. Peter Kfoury

Growing up in a Lebanese-American family, Peter started playing the oud as a teenager. He merges traditional Middle Eastern music with the rock, jazz and blues music of the 60's and 70's, and became a master of Middle Eastern Jazz Fusion. His unique blend of genres transcends boundaries with soaring melodies and driving percussion. He has performed across the US and backed up numerous singers and instrumentalists including jazz legend Rahsaan Roland Kirk. His latest album *At The Heart of Two Worlds* (2015) contains 11 original compositions plus a couple of jazz classics. theouddude.com

Reeve Coobs

This Charlotte singer-songwriter began crafting songs more than 15 years ago. Her voice is stop-you-in-your-tracks good, and her songs linger in your head and heart. Reeve toured from 2004 to 2008 with The Near Misses and is currently the vocal director for the TMP Singalong Choir. In 2013, she released her first solo record, *What Love Is All About*, and her second album, *Me + You*, was released in 2016. reevemusic.com

Randy Franklin, with his high energy band the Sardines, have been rocking the Carolinas for decades. This Alt Rock band formed in the Queen City in 2011 and released an album (*Take Flight*, 2012) and an EP (*Risk and Reward*, 2015) as a four-man band (Jim Siani, Dave Piontek, Taylor Foster, and Dan Candia). Once joined by charismatic front woman Mikaela Salazar in 2016, they recorded their album, *Zodiac* (2018), in Nashville influenced by Incubus and Halsey. Persona Bell

Singing and playing piano in her own style of soul music heavily influenced by Whitney Houston, Natalie Cole and Chaka Khan, Persona has performed in China and Norway and across the United States at venues such as Carnegie Hall, Disney Hall, The Ritz Theater, and Stage Door Theater.
